The roundtable will serve as a platform for multidimensional discussions, promoting a deeper understanding of these complex issues.

Their expertise will address systemic barriers and cultural influences affecting minorities, offering significant relevance to the research field and practical implications beyond academia.

Call for Submissions:

Ph.D. candidates and Postdoctoral researchers are invited to submit **full papers by June 24, 2024**. We particularly encourage submissions from underrepresented groups. **All economics research papers are welcome.**

The conference format includes a 25-minute presentation followed by a 5-minute Q&A for each participant. Additionally, presenters will discuss another paper for 10 minutes.
